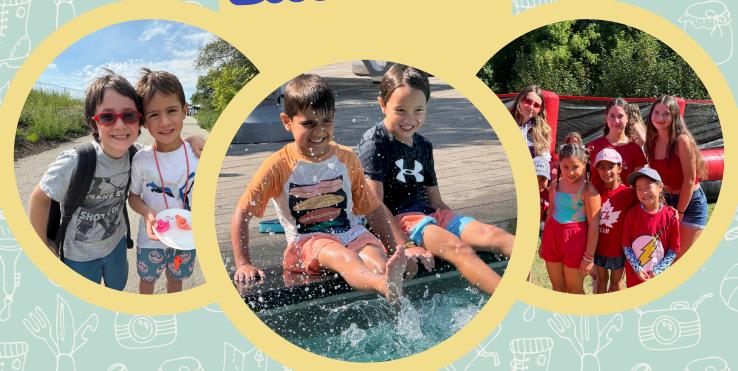

Fully Catered Lunch & Snacks

Lunch and snacks are prepared in the Richmond Hill Country Club banquet kitchen under the supervision of Executive Chef Kim Wong.

At Richmond Hill Country Club Day Camp, we provide a nut aware camp environment. This means we do not serve food with nuts or nut products.

Our meals are designed to be healthy, nutritious and kid-friendly. Vegetarian and/ or gluten-free meals can be arranged.

Snacks

Campers will receive a pre-packaged, healthy snack daily. Snacks consist of a fruit or vegetable, a dairy and a treat. Examples of the healthy snacks we serve are:

- fruit of the day
- veggies and dip
- yogurt tube

- granola bars
- goldfish crackers
- cheese strings

Campers will also receive a popsicle at the end of each day, as well as once a week the campers will have the opportunity to enjoy a mocktail at our poolside gazebo.

Lunch

The cost for lunch and snacks is included in the camp fees and consists of hot and cold food. We have scheduled the menu in a two week rotation so children don't get bored with the same lunches. All meals include a dessert.

Traditional Day Camp Program

With a fun mix of sports and other fun activities, the Richmond Hill Country Club Day Camp offers campers a great summer experience.

Campers are divided by age and placed in groups of approximately 13 campers and are supervised by our trained counsellors at all times, ensuring a safe and fun environment for kids to learn and play. We boast a low camper to staff ratio of approximately 4 campers to 1 staff member, plus our activity leaders who are with our groups throughout the day.

Each day is a unique mix of camp activities. Campers in our traditional day camp receive daily instructional swim lessons in the morning and a recreational swim in the afternoon supervised by our certified swim staff.

2026 Tennis Academy

We are excited to offer a camp that provides the best of both worlds – a half day of tennis instruction, coupled with a half day of multi-sports activities. Our Tennis Academy features 2.5 hours of instruction per day with our tennis pros, with the other half of the day featuring a variety of different sports (see "Sports Camp" description), and a daily recreational swim.

Next Generation of Players

Your child will be coached by our professionally trained tennis staff, building skills to ensure a complete learning experience. Our coaching staff, under the supervision of Patrick Amorim, will utilize a wide range of teaching and coaching disciplines to acquire the skills needed to play tennis.

Richmond Hill Golf Academy

Golf Specialty Camp

We are excited to offer a camp that provides the best of both worlds – a half day of golf instruction, coupled with a half day of multi-sports activities. Our Golf Academy will feature Golf instruction for 2.5 hours per day, with the other half of the day playing various different sports (see "Sports Camp description"), as well as a daily recreational swim.

Our Golf Academy is designed for junior golfers who have completed grade 1 through grade 7 and are either brand new to the game of golf, or have some experience and are looking to advance their skills to the next level. * Please note: application for Golfers in grades 1 and 2 will be subject to approval based on an assessment by Golf Director.

Each 2 week session will cover all of the key fundamentals of golf including, grip, stance, posture & alignment. All major swing aspects including full swing, chipping, putting and bunker play will be covered thoroughly. Our CPGA instructors will conduct a daily review in the rules of golf and course etiquette to get campers comfortable for when they are ready to hit the links on their own.

The Richmond Hill Golf Academy also features a 20 station driving range, indoor and outdoor putting green, chipping area and practice bunker. Our indoor Academy has 2 newly added Foresight Golf simulators that all golf campers will utilize day to day. These Simulators provide our Instructors with a fantastic visual tool that keeps kids engaged, and significantly enhances the learning experience. As a bonus for kids, there are some great games available including balloon pop, glass break and "Putt-Skee", a virtual Skee-ball putting game!

We recommend golf camp participants have their own set of golf clubs prior to their first day of camp; however, clubs are available to use at no additional cost.

Counsellor in Training

Leadership, friendship and fun for today's teens!











Teens love RHCC Day Camp because it is the best place for socializing with friends while developing key leadership skills to become counsellors of the future. They make some of their best camp memories in the Counselor-in-Training (CIT) program.

This complete camp training program is set up for teens who were born in 2012 or 2013 (completed grade 7 or 8) and includes courses in growth & behaviour of different age groups. Teens will learn age-appropriate games, crafts, special events for all ages, including gaining experience assisting in a group or in a specialty area.

CITs learn how to work with children and staff in a closely supervised environment. The day is structured so that CITs develop team-building skills, learn key components of caring and working with children, gaining experience through placement assignments and scheduled CIT activities.

Many of our campers who have grown up with us, find it rewarding to hone their skills as CITs before joining our camp staff as a Staff Aide. Our CIT program is designed to strike a proper balance between responsibility and fun. The tradition, skills, teamwork, spirit and friendships are an integral part of our leadership development program that will help teens gain the confidence to participate in camp life as they transition from camper to staff.

This program requires a one-month minimum commitment. Upon successful completion of the program, CITs can register for our CIT Booster program for a nominal fee.



Extended Hours Program

The Richmond Hill Country Club Day Camp is conveniently located just north of Highway 407 on Bathurst Street, making it the ideal location for driving, carpooling, biking or walking. Our convenient location means your child will not need to spend long periods of time on the bus traveling to and from camp.

We value the ability to connect with our families each day, both in the morning and at the end of the exciting camp day. For years, our reputation has been built on our strong connection with our families. The last two summers during the pandemic have only reinforced the importance of connecting with our families each day, which in turn, strongly enhances the summer camp experience for our campers.

We know that many parents choose Richmond Hill Country Club Day Camp because of the outstanding reputation of our swim program. With our heated outdoor pool and heated indoor pool, our swimming program is such a key component of the camper's day at RHCC Day Camp! We believe that swimming is a "life skill" as well as a sport and our program is designed to develop the confidence and competence of our campers in the water.

All campers (Except campers registered in the Tennis or Golf Academy and CIT Program) participate in instructional swimming lessons in the morning in a small group taught by our certified instructors as well as a fun recreational swim daily.

Your Child's Progress:

We know how important it is to keep you updated on your child's progress in the pool. At the end of each session, campers will receive an updated report indicating the skills they achieved throughout the summer as well as any badges they have earned.

Small Group Instruction:

Instruction takes place in small groups with children who have comparable swimming skills. Our swim instructors and counsellors provide small group lessons, and make swimming a positive, comfortable activity. Our youngest campers receive instruction in the shallow end of the pool. Our instruction caters to all levels of experience, from the child still learning to blow bubbles to the child perfecting their advanced strokes. A key to our swim program's success is the personalization of your child's program. Each camper's progress is monitored by their swim instructor to ensure they are learning at the pace that is just right for them.

RHCC Day Camp Summer 2026 Frequently Asked Questions

Can I request that my child be grouped with their friends?

We make every effort to ensure that each child receives at least one mutual friend request. You are able to indicate such requests on your registration form or you can email the camp at j.wolkoff@richmondhillcountryclub.com. Please note that our cabin groups are designed based on similar ages. Requests that are too wide in age range will not be accommodated as it impacts the quality of the experience and programs for all campers. Please note that requests for friends are subject to availability in the group depending upon registration date.

Can I make changes to my camp registration?

Sessions may be moved within Summer 2026 at no extra cost as long as there is space availability. Extending your child(ren)'s number of weeks at camp (example: extending from 2 to 4 weeks) will be subject to availability and the fees that are in effect at the time of the change. Shortening your child(ren)'s enrolment dates (example: shortening your weeks from 6 to 4 weeks) prior to May 1, 2026 will result in your camp fees being adjusted for the enrolled weeks and a refund will be available for the outstanding balance. After April 1, 2026 no refunds are permitted.

















Does camp still operate on rainy days or during extreme heat days?

Yes! We are very fortunate to boast a world class indoor facility right next door. While we still have some outdoor activities on hot days, we do have large periods of time where campers are brought indoors to our air-conditioned facilities, including our tennis courts and multi-purpose rooms. Unlike other camps, our programs go on without a hitch, with some minor adjustments. We are also fortunate to have an indoor pool and we swim rain or shine!

Can I only register for one week?

Our sessions are in two-week increments. Having campers remain for a two-week period ensures that they are able to get the most out of their camp experience. This allows for campers to establish strong friendships over a two-week period and experience all of the great programs in a two-week period.



RHCC Day Camp Summer 2026 Terms & Conditions

1. Payment Policies

- Applications cannot be confirmed unless accompanied by the required deposit or full payment of camp fees
 per child. Your child(ren) will only be permitted to start camp once fees are paid in full prior to the start of their
 camp session
- A deposit of \$250 per camper per session is submitted at the time of enrollment. This deposit will hold your child's spot until April 30, 2026.
- Full payment for summer is due on April 30, 2026.
- Any registrations received after April 30, 2026 will only be considered confirmed once the full payment has been made, subject to availability.

2. Credit Card Transaction Fee

A Credit Card Transaction Fee of 2.4% will apply to the balance of payment due after the deposit is paid.

To avoid the 2.4% fee, you can choose one of the following alternate payment methods:

• e-Transfer or Cheque

3. Cancellation Policies

- Worry free, FULL refunds before January 31st, 2026(requests must be in writing). Lock in your rates early and if your plans change before January 31st, let us know and we will give you a full refund, no guestions asked!
- Cancellations made between February 1st and April 1st will be honoured, less 50% of deposit per session per child
- Cancellations requested after April 1st, 2026: We do not offer refunds or credits
- Sessions may be moved or extended within Summer 2026 at no extra cost, subject to space and availability.
- Extending your child(ren)'s number of weeks at camp (example: extending from 2 to 4 weeks) will be subject to availability and the fees that are in effect at the time of the change. Shortening your child(ren)'s enrolment dates (example: shortening your weeks from 6 to 4 weeks) prior to April 1st, 2026 will result in your camp fees being adjusted for the enrolled weeks and a refund will be available for the outstanding balance. NOTE: Discounts provided in original enrolment will be reversed if enrolment is shortened.
- If the Government does not allow the entire camp to operate for all or a portion of the Camp season in 2026 the camp will reimburse a full 100% refund of the camp fees paid for the period of the Government Shutdown which affects the period of time the camp is not able to operate.
- All refunds will be issued on October 1st 2026.
- Richmond Hill Country Club Day Camp. reserves the right to terminate the registration of any camper if, in the
 opinion of the Directors, it is in the best interest of the child or the camp. In such event, a proportional refund
 will be made

4. Missed Camp Policies

- Our fees are for a service over a specified session or session and are not a day-to-day fees.
- Missing camp days for any reason will not be subject to any refunds or pro-rating of fees.
- Camp days missed cannot be made up at a later date in the summer.

5. Public Health Policies

- The Camp follows the Ministry of Health guidelines and protocols. For the 2026 camp season, we will continue to follow the guidelines and protocols that may be required to operate safely.
- Richmond Hill Country Club Day Camp reserves the right to impose protocols to conform to all Public Health requirements imposed from time to time.

6. Community Guidelines

All camp families agree to maximize the health and safety of our camp community by:

- Abiding by current Public Health measures in day-to-day (non-camp) life, whatever they may be at the time.
- Being diligent about illness. It is extremely important to keep campers home if they are experiencing any signs of illness. Return-to-camp policies will be updated based on our local public health unit's recommendations at the time.
- The Camp will provide any protocols that will be required by York Region Public Health prior to the start of Camp. Parents must also adhere to the Public Health Mandates established for Campers and Staff.

7. **Program Offerings**

RHCC Day Camp reserves the right to alter specific aspects of our program as may be restricted by Public Health measures during Summer 2026.
